The Youth will be having a Charlie Brown Thanksgiving on Sunday, November 13th at the Peters' residence. Then, on Sunday

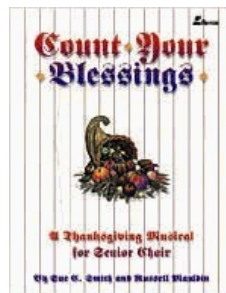
Nov. 20th the Youth leave for YEC and return on Monday the 21st.

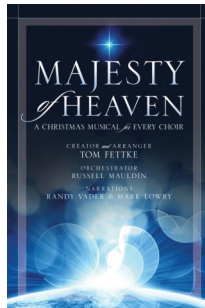
All this being said doesn't even mention all the other holiday events that are planned during the next two months. So, like I alluded to earlier, let's get busy.

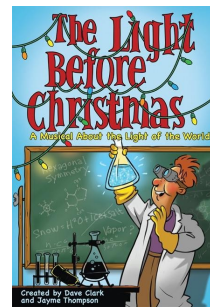

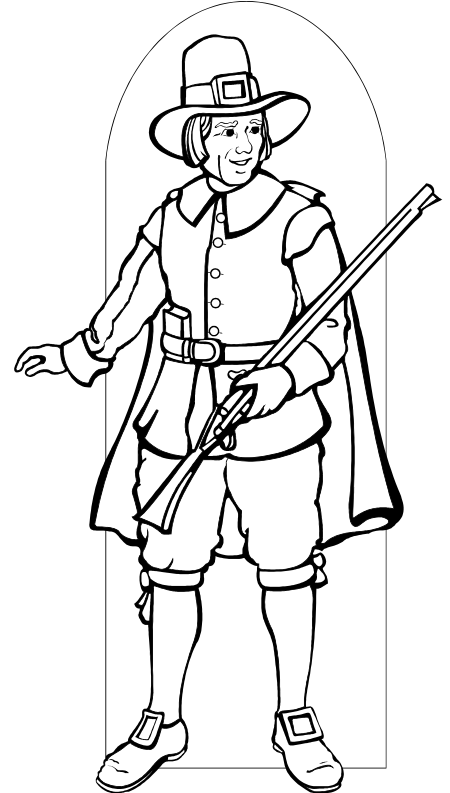
